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Dress Code: Every student is required to arrange his/her own uniform. It is mandatory for all students to wear full uniform during the classes and other academic activities. Dress Code for CIMS Bwp is as under:

- a. **MALES:** White shirt (full sleeves) with grey pants, Black Oxford pattern shoes, White overall.
- b. **FEMALES:** white Qameez (full sleeves) white shalwar with white dupatta, Black shoes & white Overall.

Books. Stationary shop is available at CIMS Bwp, where all necessary books are available at appropriate prices

Note: For first one week, there will be no restrictions on uniform but students are directed to wear sober colour dress (girls to wear Shalwar Qameez with Dupatta and boys to wear Dress Pants with Dress Shirts (with sweaters/ coat etc).

Laces & embroidery on uniform, Tights, jeans, joggers and heel shoes are not permissible. Violation of dress code is considered as disciplinary violation for which there is punishment/ fine

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR HOSTEL STUDENTS

1. Limited seats are available for hostel accommodation which has been allotted purely on merit. All rooms are biseaters. the allotment of rooms is also made as per merit however, exchange of room may be permitted to students only with the consent of respective roommates and prior permission of college administration. All boarding students must note that following facilities are available for each student in the CIMS Hostels:-

- a. Three meals per day including Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner to be served in dining halls at prescribed timings. Students are **NOT** required to bring un-necessary crockery items with them.
- b. Furniture incl Single bed with mattress, Bed side table, Closet/ Cupboard & Study Chair & Rack. Students will bring own bedding including pillow, bed sheet, blanket etc.
- c. Air Conditioned will be purchased and installed by students, monthly electric charges will be charged as per actual consumption.
- d. Free medical checkup (outdoor only) from CMH Bwp in case of illness.
- e. Free pick and drop from bus stand while going on holidays or on return, unscheduled tpt requirement will be charged from students.
- f. Indoor games incl Table Tennis, Carem Board, Ludo etc. are available.
- g. Free Laundry Facility is available.
- h. Students who are willing to stay in single room, they have to pay extra charges per year as per schedule.

2. Instructions

- a. For visiting Cantt Market and designated locations in local market, the out pass is allowed once per week depending upon Covid situation at prescribed timings after the classes. Girl students are accompanied by hostel Asst Warden during out pass. Only College vehicle is used to take students from markets. However, students may be allowed to go on out pass with their parents or NOK.
- b. A purchase boy is also available in girls, hostels who can be utilized to bring routine items from market once daily. For the daily purchase, students will hand over the list of items with cash to the Assistant Warden before 8.00 AM in morning & 4.00 PM in evening. After that no request will be entertained.
- c. Out pass rules will be strictly followed. Out pass may be stopped for a student for week or more if he/ she visits un-authorized places, returns late from out pass or demands out pass frequently for un-necessary reasons.
- d. On arrival, student must produce original CNIC of Parents/ NOK for recording of necessary information regarding future visits/ communication by them.

- e. Only parents/ NOK (incl the persons mentioned in admission form) are allowed (only on holidays) to visit the boarding students. For visit of guests/ visitors on any other days, students must seek advance permission (with reasons of visit) from Warden.

- f. Visitors/ guests are not allowed to enter the hostels. Students will meet the visitors/ guests in the visitors room only.
- j. Students are **Not allowed** to keep electric appliances (fridge, electric heater, iron & microwave oven etc) in their rooms. Unauthorized items will be confiscated.
- h. Students are not allowed to stay in the rooms during hours of classes **(0800 to 1500 hrs)** except those permitted or those on exam preparatory leave or due to sickness.
- i. Students are not allowed to keep prohibited drugs, narcotics & fire arms in their rooms.
- j. The students are not permitted to be involved in any sort of political, sectarian, ethnic, religious and other such activities in hostels. If any student is found involved in such activities his/her hostel allotment will be cancelled.
- k. Students must **NOT** keep gold items, heavy amount of cash, valuables & precious items in their rooms. CIMS authorities will not be responsible for any loss/ theft.
- l. In case of any deliberate damage to the furniture or other items by the students, financial penalty will be imposed to the concerned student.
- m. Any act of misconduct or breach of hostel rules by a student will be referred to the CIMS Disciplinary Committee which may recommend fine / expulsion or dismissal from hostel.
